- 1.0 The Government of Ghana intends to improve access to quality secondary education in the country. It has therefore made budgetary provision and approached Development Partners to support its Community Senior High Schools program. In line with this, the World Bank has provided a credit of US\$ 156 million under the Secondary Education Improvement Project (SEIP).
- 2.0 The Government of Ghana, acting through the Ministry of Education, intends to apply part of the funds allocated for the above Project to cover eligible payments under contracts for the completion of the construction of structures indicated in the table below.

- 3.0 Bidding will be conducted through the procedures specified in the World Bank Guidelines and Public Procurement Act 2003, (Act 663) amended Act 2016, (Act 914) and open to all bidders from eligible source countries as determined by the Bank and registered by the Ministry of Works and Housing in the category stated above.
- 4.0 Bidders may bid for any of the Lots and may be awarded multiple contract Lots based on an assessment of verifiable documentary evidence of the bidder's capacity to execute multiple contract lots simultaneously.
- 5.0 Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the Bid Documents from the Ministry of Education at the address indicated below during the office hours from 0800 hours to 1700 hours from 18th May, 2017.
- 6.0 A complete set of Documents in English may be purchased on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee as specified in 2.0 above. The method of payment will be cash.
- 7.0 Bidding will be conducted through the procedures specified in the World Bank Guidelines and Public Procurement Act (PPA). The Ministry of Education now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the above lots.
- 8.0 Bids must be deposited into the box located at the address below at or before 10:00 hours GMT on Thursday, 15th June 2017. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline of submission. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidder's representative who chooses to attend at the Conference Room of the Ministry of Education at 10.00 hours GMT on 15th June 2017.
